SC Cllr Picton report: In Cllr Picton's absence Cllr Ed Potter reported. Due to the upcoming general election on 4th July SC is in "Purdah".

SC's last year's overspend was less than expected. Moving forward the situation looks to be more promising. The Riverside redevelopment will start soon. The drainage in this area is complicated by centuries of building. VAS; it will make sense to treat the Holyhead Road, from Shelton to Montford Bridge, as one project. The SC officer in charge of this project, David Gradwell, is off sick at the moment. Shrewsbury Town Centre, Traffic Control, the idea behind the plan is to allow traffic in to the centre of town for access to businesses but to prevent through traffic. This is still at the planning stage.
